

# Cave Diver 2 course (CD2, Cave Diver)



# **Training objectives**

This is a more experienced cave diver with the knowledge on the correct usage of the required equipment and the skills to safely plan and organize cave dives in **zone 2 (cave, no more natural light**) and to execute them in the company of other certified cave divers of same or higher level.

He masters all techniques to orient himself even under zero visibility and total loss of light or during a silt-out and is able to find safely back to the entrance.

The use of Nitrox mixtures up to 40 % is acceptable if Nitrox Diver certification has been obtained beforehand.

# **Course programm (content)**

- 1 day classroom theory (approx. 6 hrs)
- 1 day practical exercises (refresher) in a lake (overall divetime approx. 3 hrs)
- France: 6 days practical exercises (8-10 dives in the cavern and cave zone of at least 4 caves)
- Switzerland: 3-4 days practical exercies (min. 6 dives) in the cavern and cave zone of at least 3 caves)

## **Prerequisites**

## a) course admission

- 2\* diver CMAS or equivalent
- cave diver 1 SCD/CMAS or equivalent
- 50 logged dives
- 10 logged night dives

## b) compulsory specialty certificates

Nitrox Diver CMAS or equivalent

#### c) entry-assessment

At the discretion of the course director to guarantee the requested entry-level.

#### Equipment

- complete set of standard sport diver equipment for cold waters; PLUS:
- 2 independent tanks of equal size OR 2 connected tanks (double tank set) with isolator valve. Min. capacity 3200 bar\*liter (2x8L/200bar). 1 SPG per tank. DIN connectors only!
- 1 low pressure longhose 1.8-2.1m
- **3 independent** lamp systems (2 main lamps+1 backup-lamp *OR* 1 main lamp+2 backup-lamps), of which 1 lamp with non-recharchable batteries. Performance main lamp: 30-50W Halogen / 12-18W HID; backup lamp: min. 4W Xenon

• SCD and / or CMAS double card

Is in the full responsibility of each participant.

- minimum 18 years old
- until certification: 5 dives in zone 1 in min. 2 different caverns since CD1

- 2 solid cutting tools, secured against dropping
- 1 uw-wrist slate with pencil
- 3 line arrows+3 non-directional cookies
- 1 safety reel with min. 50m line
- 1 jump/gap reel/spool with min. 30m line
- 1 primary reel with min. 80m line
- min. 1 dive-/decompression computer
- 1 helmet, 1 backup-mask, 1 compass
- recommended: 1 deco tank O2, content min. 800 bar\*liter (4liter/200bar)
- Certificate, format A4
